Itikaaf Rules & Regulations

1. The applicant must fill the Application Form properly and submitted to the sub-committee Members.
2. A copy of a valid Australian Driver's License and/or Passport needs to be attached with the application form during submission.
3. Applicant must be 18 years of age or older to be eligible to participate in the Itikaaf.
4. No one other than registered individuals in Itikaaf will be allowed in the designated areas for Itikaaf.
5. Only one piece of luggage per person will be allowed in the masjid. Please bring items with you such as sleeping bags, blankets, pillows, personal items, etc. CIC will not be providing any of these items.
6. Male Participants will be sleeping towards the back of the Masjid; and the female participants will be sleeping in the women praying area upstairs. Day time all sleeping items will be kept together neatly at the back.
7. There will be no food and drinks allowed in the Masjid. Only water in securely capped bottles and containers is allowed. No open cups or containers inside the Masjid.
8. THERE WILL BE NO FACILITIES TO COOK FOOD. Participants are required to arrange their food to be delivered. The Community Hall kitchen can be used to store the food in the refrigerator and warm up using Microwave ONLY.
9. NO PERSONAL WARMERS, HEATERS, COOKERS, ETC. WILL BE ALLOWED.
10. No buying or selling of any items will be allowed at the CIC premises.
11. Lights will be turned off/dimmed for sleeping after Suhr and Fajr prayer every day. Please be considerate and not disturbing others.
12. There will be a quiet time after night prayer until Fajr prayer for individual's ibadah and sleeping.
13. Participants are not required to sleep but must remain quiet. Any discussion or study sessions must be carried out during daytime.
14. Those listening to Quran recitation must use an earphone or headphones. Mobile phones will only be allowed for emergency use and must be in silent mode throughout the duration of Itikaaf.
15. All participants must keep the masjid area and hall kitchen area clean, including bathroom facilities.
16. Everyone is requested to respect other participants, regardless of age, and make extra effort to make the Itikaaf a good experience for all.
17. Failure to comply with these rules and regulations can and will result in actions resulting to being asked to leave the premises; we strongly suggest all brothers and sisters to cooperate with the Masjid Management Committee.
18. CIC is not responsible for any loss or damage of any participant's personal property. CIC insurance will not cover any personal injuries.
19. The applicant bears all responsibility and liability and hereby agrees to indemnify CIC its Executive Committee members fully and absolutely Masjid sub-committee members and employees from any liability. Applicant agrees to abide by CIC's Code of Conduct and other policies. Anything not described in detail in this form will be decided on and at the sole discretion of the Masjid Sub-Committee.
